Recycled Stringybark decking 75x28mm (mixed Class 2 & 3 species) \$55.00/m² There are many uses for an oversized decking board. At 28mm it can be installed with either a leading edge or a leading face to good effect as screening. The thickness allows for greater robustness in benches, walkways or decks. I've a regular client, a shopfitter, who is busy fitting out a clothing store with this product at the moment: racks, rails, shelves and partitions.....

Recycled Mountain Ash 70x19mm normally \$48.00/m² but until current stocks are sold this is on offer at \$45.00/m². (5 packs). A light brown, straw-toned timber with oak-like crown features and black feather, mountain ash suits a contemporary coastal style of interior.

KD Forest Red Gums NFG 80x19mm \$49.00/m². A blend of Forest Red Gum and Red Ironbark this feature grade flooring swarms with fiddleback and deep crimsons. Available for red-lovers next few months only.

Recycled Tasmanian Blue Gum 140x19mm. \$79.00/m². Milled from 75mm thick purlins from a Preston factory, these boards brought groans from the sawyers and machinists at Timberzoo from the sheer weight of the timber. Milled to flooring it garnered sighs of appreciation: Ribbons of blackcurrant, eddies of birdseye, shoals of fiddleback and a hum of black speck. Colour range from mulberry through macchiato to white coffee. There's only 300m² so don't delay.
